SPIRITUAL PREPARATION

Father, as we prepare to step into a new year to inherit the blessings that You have promised us, we ask that You cleanse us from anything that is not like You (Psalm 51:10). Sanctify us, make us ready to be used for Your glory and honor. (Joshua 3:5). In Jesus' name, Amen.



COURAGE UNDER FIRE

Father, we pray for leadership "everywhere" to be strong and of a good courage. (Joshua 1:6-7). We pray for leaders to stand strong under the "pressures of life." We are commanded to pray for those in authority that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty, (1 Timothy 2:1-2). In Jesus' name, Amen.

JESUS, I'll NEVER FORGET

Father, When You work a miracle in our lives, help us to remember to say "thank you."
